Week 2	2 Traditions, Pageants and Ceremonies ... The Rose Water Bowl, sung grace, receiving lines. Toasts and speeches. Events common to all Livery Companies and those particular to specific Companies.
Week 3	3 Dress Code - inviting, thanking and attending events To include Consorts' days. Your own day. Speech making. Toasts and grace. When to wear your badge, to hat or not!
Week 4	4 The role of the Master, Wardens, Court of Assistants, role of Clerk and Beadle
Week 5	5 The Lord Mayor and Sheriffs and the Lord Mayor's Show To include the election of the Lord Mayor and Sheriffs, and the installation of the Lord Mayor (Silent Ceremony).
Week 6	6 The City of London Corporation and the Guildhall. To include Court of Common Council, Court of Aldermen and wards.

Every week fitting together the pieces of the Livery and the Mayoralty, working alongside the City of London Corporation with their traditions and pageantry.
